Morrison Maierle presented for approval Amendment No. 2 modifications to the Exxon Connection Study Contract. Morrison Maierle is to provide additional analysis and a report Amendment to the Exxon Connection Study. Compensation for additional services will be \$8,600 bringing the project ceiling to \$31,703.07. The report Amendment will be completed within eight weeks of the effective date of contract Amendment, which is June 3, 2018. Exxon will cover the cost for the additional study.

Intake project Update

The project is 95.3% completed. The equipment has been installed, and the project is proceeding with testing and startup. Final pay application should be submitted at the August Board meeting.

Sewer PER Update

There is nothing new to report on the Sewer PER, and is on hold for now. The water PER is complete. Nittany Grantworks is getting ready to submit a grant application to TSEP on June 15th.

Lift Station Update

The Western Municipal contract is signed, and the pump has been ordered. Western

Municipal is planning on starting on the lift station project sometime after the 4th of July.

The water pumping record is as follows:

Manager Ariztia advised that currently there are 105 Phase 2 connections. There are at least five connections that are probably going to happen in the next couple weeks. Between Phase 1 and Phase 2, there are 267 paid. Out of the 267 that are paid, 226 are connected into the system. In the Phase 1 sewer system, Town Pump, Prince Trucking and Titan Machinery will be connecting to the system very soon.

A postcard was presented for Board approval to be sent out to the water users advising that the 2017 Annual Drinking Water Quality Report was available online and a paper copy is available at the main office. It also advised that the Phase 2 Sewer Sub-district System Development Fee was delayed to take effect on July 1, 2019, and a reminder that the new water and sewer residential rates take effect on July 1, 2018.
