* Rate study update (Andrew Rheem with Raftelis financial Consultants, Inc.)

Andrew Rheem of Raftelis presented an update on the 2020 Financial Plan and Rate Setting Overview presented via telephone at the May, 2021 Board meeting.

Water Plan adjustments proposed were the delay of some capital expenditures including main replacements and upgrades, fire flow upgrades and Mid-Zone Reservoir 2; increasing current System Development Fees by 3% per year starting 7/1/22; and, increased funding of growth-related improvements.

Sewer fund financial plan adjustments since the May, 2021 presentation included delayed Vactor Truck until FY 2024-25; reviewed debt service coverage calculated to exclude debt repaid by assessments; Phase 3 is excluded (additional customers help reduce costs for existing customers).

Exxon volume reduction anticipates reduction in volume and revenue, rates increased offsetting much of the costs. Reduced cash reserve target to \$0.5M, increases to \$0.8M by FY 2029-30.

Rates projected will be over five-year period through 7/1/25. New rates will be presented to the public at the July, 2021 public meeting.

The next steps are as follows:

Notice of public hearing will be advertised June 25 and July 2, mailed to customers July 1, and public meeting to be held on July 14. Mailing to customers to include an estimate of what the customer may be charged.

After discussion, the Board recommended the base rates on sewer and water stay the same, with an increase in the volume rates on both water and sewer.

Phase 3 will have its own connection fees, and will connect into Phase 1 infrastructure. Phase 3 should be relatively similar to Phase 2. System Development Fees for Water will remain the same as now, to be increased by inflation over the next four years.

The rates will be reevaluated in five years.

* Water Treatment Plant Expansion Update

Jill Cook reported RSCI is working on filter-to-waste piping. They will be de-watering and then starting the mass excavation. It's been a slow start and there's not a lot to report, but things are going to start picking up. Contract completion is anticipated for March, 2022.

The Board is looking for an replacement Board member. One candidate has expressed interest in the position.
